



KEEPING NELMES PRE-SCHOOL COVID19 SAFE

Nelmes Pre-School staff are taking every precaution to keep the environment safe for both children and staff. The measures in place are in-line with government guidance and are as follows:

Nelmes Pre-School staff will not have contact with individuals who are unwell or are showing COVID19 symptoms.

It is an expectation that parents of children attending Nelmes Pre-School do not send their children to school if they are feeling unwell, showing signs of a temperature or if their children have a cough. It is vital parents adhere to this! Note to parents – Do not enter premises if you, yourself, are displaying symptoms of COVID19.

Parents and visitors are not permitted to enter the Pre-School without a pre-arranged appointment.

Only one parent to accompany your child to school.

For children that need to bring blankets or comforters into setting to aid their wellbeing and settling into the environment will be permitted. However, we would ask that these items are laundered daily. Preferred toys and play items will not be permitted into setting to minimise the risk of infection transmission.

Hand washing and hand sanitising of both staff and children are more frequent in setting.

Good respiratory hygiene in setting by promoting the 'catch it, bin it, kill it' approach.

Nelmes Pre-School staff will ensure the cleaning of frequently touched surfaces and resources using products that kill 99.99% of bacteria and viruses in 60 seconds. (Product kills Coronavirus, Influenza A, MRSA, Listeria, Salmonella and E.coli. Tested to BS EN 14476, BS EN 1276 and BS EN 13697).
